Greetings Incoming Eagle Alliance!

We want to welcome all our new incoming freshmen from Jackson, Queens, San Jacinto and Southmore. We are expecting a large class of freshman that is going to help take us to new heights and even more success!

In this letter you will be receiving the schedule for the summer, which will include not only our summer band practices but also our performance calendar for the fall season. We expect everyone to be here – NO EXCUSES. The only way a band learns to be an ensemble is when all of the parts are present to learn. We will be determining who earns a spot in the marching show or who starts as an alternate based not only on musical performance, but also attendance. Be sure to post your copy of the schedule somewhere in the house so you do not forget!!!

Freshmen report for marching camp on Monday and Tuesday July 22 & 23. Full band rehearsals with everyone will begin on Wednesday, July 24 and continue throughout the Fall Semester. Refer to the attached calendar for the specific rehearsal times. IMPORTANT NOTE: All students are required to turn in a physical before they can attend any outdoor marching practices!!!

The **Kruse Clinic** located at 400 Park Lane, Pasadena, TX 77506 offers free physicals to all current and incoming Pasadena High Students. You can schedule a physical with them. Their phone number is (832) 658-5230 and their website url is <https://memorialhermann.org/locations/kruse-health-center>. Please get your physical done before Jul 22nd.

Marching band is as athletic as any sport. We need everyone to be in top physical and mental condition daily. You must remember to get plenty of rest, eat a good breakfast (but do NOT have milk!), and drink water before you arrive each morning. In the heat of July and August, we do our best to give quick water breaks every 10-15 minutes, so bring plenty of water to take advantage of that. There are a few daily things all students should bring to each rehearsal to be properly prepared: Some sort of Hat or Cap; Athletic Shirt or Short Sleeve Shirt; Athletic Shorts; Laced Tennis Shoes; 1/2 Gallon Water Jug (This can be found at Walmart, Academy, or Any Sports Store); Sun Screen; (Optional) Any type of Sunglasses.

We need everyone to have Parent Square. This is how we will be communicating with you for next year. Please login and look over Parent Square, it is different than remind which is what we used last year.

Also, please don't forget to sign up for our Google Classroom: <https://classroom.google.com/c/NjYwODY4NDU4Mzcw?cjc=h3gu2b3>. We will include links to music and our Google Calendar. The calendar will always be up to date on this site. We will also have assignments done through Google Classroom throughout the school year.

Everyone must sign up for **Rank One Sport** by following the directions listed on the Rank One Sport handout. The online forms require both a parent/guardian and student signature. The parent guardian and student must fill out the forms together. Fill them out entirely, put information in all boxes and fill all boxes. Both forms must be completed. This should be done before the first rehearsal.

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There is an order form attached to this letter. The sooner we get these order forms turned in, the sooner we can order that items. We will probably not be wearing full uniforms to the first few games. It is a necessity that all students have a band shirt to wear at these games. All students will also have to have the marching band shoes that are listed on the form.

We will have **Five Summer Rehearsals** . While they are not required, we would certainly like everyone in town to show up for them. At the very least, try to make one. In order to help entice the students to do so, we will be having a fun trip before each of the rehearsals.

On **Thursday, May 30th**, the band will meet at the band hall at 12:00pm to go to the **Houston Galleria**. The Houston Galleria is free. Students will be responsible for lunch, any other food they choose to eat, and all entertainment. As with the other trips, we need chaperones, so please send a Parent Square to the band directors and volunteer. Permission slips (included with this letter) must be on file for each student. Upon returning, we will have our bi-weekly summer rehearsal from 6-8pm.

On **Friday, June 14th**, the band will meet at the band hall at 2:00pm to have our bi-weekly summer rehearsal. At 4:00pm, we will load the buses and go to the **Space Cowboys vs. Oklahoma City Baseball Game** in Sugar Land. The Space Cowboy Game costs \$16. Students will need to have turned in their money for the Space Cowboys Game no later than Friday, May 31st. At this game there is a giveaway of a Kyle Tucker Replica Space City Jersey. We will make sure that we make the game in time for everyone to receive the giveaway. Students will be responsible for dinner, any other food they choose to eat. As with the other trips, we need chaperones, so please send a Parent Square to the band directors and volunteer. Permission slips (included with this letter) must be on file for each student.

On **Wednesday, June 26th**, the band will meet at the band hall at 10:00am to have our bi-weekly summer rehearsal. At 12:00pm, we will load the buses and go to the **Pleasure Pier** in Galveston. The Pleasure Pier costs \$18. Students will need to have turned in their money for the Pleasure Pier no later than Friday, June 14th. Students will be responsible for lunch, any other food they choose to eat. As with the other trips, we need chaperones, so please send a Parent Square to the band directors and volunteer. Permission slips (included with this letter) must be on file for each student.

On **Wednesday, July 10th**, the band will meet at the band hall at 2:00pm to have our bi-weekly summer rehearsal. At 5:00pm, we will load the buses and go to the **Astros vs. Marlins Baseball Game** at Minute Maid Park. The Astros vs. Marlins Game costs \$17. Students will need to have turned in their money for the Astros Game no later than Wednesday, June 26th. Students will be responsible for dinner, any other food they choose to eat. As with the other trips, we need chaperones, so please send a Parent Square to the band directors and volunteer. Permission slips (included with this letter) must be on file for each student.

On **Friday, July 19th**, the band will meet at the band hall at 4:00pm to have our bi-weekly summer rehearsal. At 6:00pm, we will load the buses and go to the **Summer Symphony Nights** at Miller Outdoor Theater. The Summer Symphony Nights is free. It is recommended that they bring a blanket, we will be watching the Houston Symphony from the grass. Students can bring their own food to eat while the Houston Symphony is performing. Students will be responsible for dinner, any other food they choose to eat, and all entertainment. As with the other trips, we need chaperones, so please send a Parent Square to the band directors and volunteer. Permission slips (included with this letter) must be on file for each student.

Realice su examen físico antes del 22 de julio.

La banda de música es tan atlética como cualquier deporte. Necesitamos que todos estén en óptimas condiciones físicas y mentales diariamente. Debes recordar descansar lo suficiente, desayunar bien (¡pero NO tomar leche!) y beber agua antes de llegar cada mañana. En el calor de julio y agosto, hacemos todo lo posible para dar descansos rápidos para tomar agua cada 10 a 15 minutos, así que traiga mucha agua para aprovechar eso. 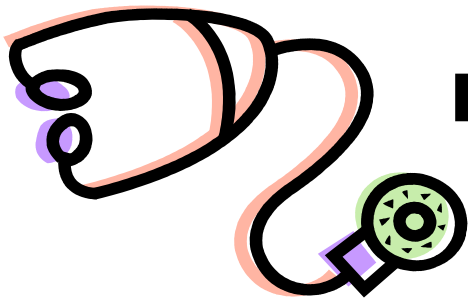

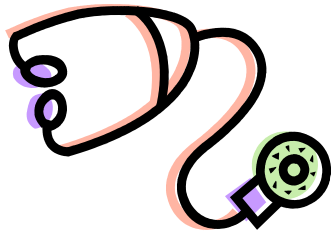

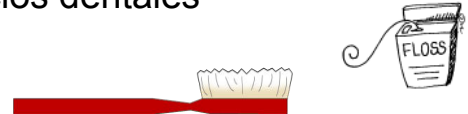
